



### FITTING DOOR SEALS – NON CLIPPED

Tools you will need:

- Scissors/Shears
- Blunt Screwdriver
- Superglue or Contact Adhesive.

1. Check the replacement seal is of correct type, size & length.

PLEASE NOTE: This replacement seal may not be exactly the same profile as your original door rubber. Take careful note of the way your old door seal fits to the door, before removal, to ensure correct replacement.

2. Channel & Glue Type: Start at the corner, carefully pushing the rubber into place with your fingers or a blunt screwdriver (soapy water makes it easier) Commence gluing the new door seal where the channel ends. Work towards the bottom of the door, cut to length & join with superglue under the door.

WARNING: Superglue is the quickest & cleanest method of fitting door seals but always 'WORK' short lengths as it sets immediately and cannot be easily removed.
