

FITTING DOOR APERTURE SEALS

Tools you will need:

- Rubber Mallet
- Side Cutters or Large Scissors.
- 1. Check the replacement seal is a similar type of seal, and is similar in size and length to the original.
- 2. Position one end of the Pinchweld at your selected start point and using the palm of your hand, or a rubber mallet, push into place
- 3. Cut the new seal to length once it is in place, and superglue the two ends together.

WARNING: Pinchwelds do shrink with age, so do not stretch into place. Pack tightly into corners and leave surplus if possible, under the door scuff plates.
